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# Key Word Sign



## Spring

How to sign it:

Hold one hand flat a short distance in front of body, with fingers pointing towards opposite side and palm facing chest. Start with the fingers of your other hand bunched together and pointing upwards just below flat hand. Move this hand upwards behind flat hand and spread fingers apart as hand emerges.



## Flower

How to sign it:

Form an O shape with pointer finger and thumb, keeping other fingers straight (OK hand). Starting with thumb and pointer tips to the side of nostril; move hand in an arc under nose to the side of the other nostril.



## Bird

How to sign it:

Bring pinched fingers in front of mouth and open and close, like a bird's beak.
