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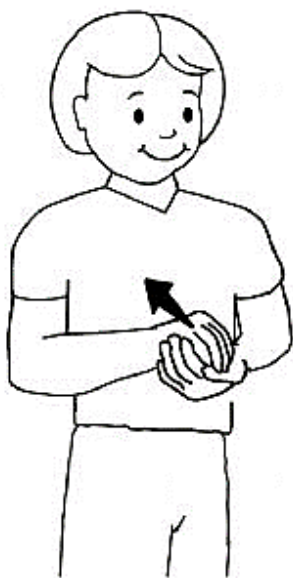
PBL update

Respectful

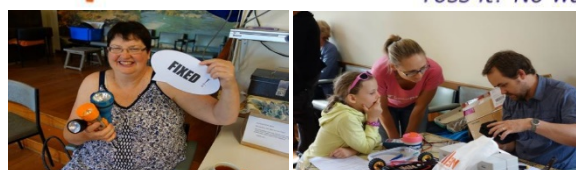




Please join us for our Assembly and see the creative T-Shirt Designs by our senior students for Book Week.
