Key Word Sign



Count

How to sign it:

With fingers spread, palm towards chest, wiggle fingers and move hand upwards.



Backward

How to sign it:

Hold both hands bent in front of you at sides, so that fingertips face each other.

Simultaneously move hand backwards towards body. (Thumbs may be held up or in)



One Hundred

How to sign it:

Start by extending pointer finger from fist with palm backwards (sign for 1). Then bring hand towards face and tap side of pointer finger to side of opposite cheek and chin.

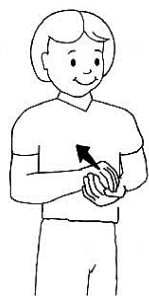
