Key Word Sign



Eat



How to sign it: Move hand, with thumb touching fingers, towards mouth twice.

Drink

In the morning and afternoon students arrive and depart in busses and cars, bikes, and walking. It is a very busy and hectic time. Please make sure that you drive into the secured area and wait for gates to close before students exit or enter vehicles. **Students are not** to enter or exit vehicles unescorted outside of the secured gates. Also, drivers please watch your speed and make sure you park legally.

A big reminder- please inform the school if your child is absent and ensure they are at school by 9am.
